
Dear Administrator Williams:

The City of Conroe, a community I represent within the Eighth District of Texas, is applying for the FY2020 Grants for Buses and Bus Facilities Program (5339b). If selected, the city will use this funding to improve the City's transit system, Conroe Connection, and meet the requirements set by the U.S. Department of Transportation's Transit Asset Management (TAM).

As the fastest growing city in Texas and one of the fastest growing in the country, Conroe, Texas is undergoing tremendous change. To accommodate this expansion, it is important Conroe provides reliable, updated infrastructure for the safety and health of its citizens. For individuals who are unable to access health care and services independently, reliable infrastructure is necessary and this grant would ensure individuals have access to resources they need. By 2023, the vehicles used by Conroe Connection will no longer meet the requirements set by USDOT. This grant will replace eight of the existing buses and expand the existing routes services, enhancing to meet the needs of various riders in the community.
